Factsheet SWITCHEngines

The SWITCHEngines service

- Self-service virtual machines and storage
- Service operated by SWITCH and connected to SWITCHlan
- Virtual machine templates for Linux (CentOS, Debian, Ubuntu), Windows 2012 Svr¹
- Define number of cores, RAM, storage capacity, public IP address
- Volume storage attachable to Virtual Machines
- S3 object storage
- Data is stored redundantly
- Save Virtual Machine state using snapshot functionality
- Individually configurable firewall

Status

- Pilot phase from October 2014 to end of 2015
- The service is free within the pilot phase
- Free usage for projects within the CUS P-2 program
- Usage for other projects: conditions to be negotiated

Tariff
