SIG e-Portfolio

SIG Leader: Patrick Roth, UNIGE

The aim of the SIG e-Portfolio is to determine the usage of e-portfolio elaborating pedagogical recommendations and defining if there is a common need for a national instance of an e-portfolio that would among other features cover lifelong storage. In order to do so, the SIG launched a survey to identify e-portfolio practices and needs, and since then organises workshops to focus on pedagogical and technological aspects. After having produced several types of guidelines, the focus will now be on raising awareness for e-portfolios. The aim is to help new users getting started by informing them about existing possibilities, introducing practical examples and giving them guidance.
